Student Immunization Requirements

II. Policy

In compliance with the <u>State of Texas Higher Education Mandatory Immunization Requirements</u>; the recommendations of the <u>Texas Department of State Health Services Immunization Division, including the Texas minimum requirements for Student Enrolled in Healthcare coursework; and the <u>recommendations</u> of the <u>Department of Health and Human Services Center for Disease Control and Prevention</u>, all students are required to complete the required immunizations as a condition of enrollment.</u>

All immunizations required in healthcare or research areas must be completed before a student may participate in any activity.

NOTE: Certain areas of study, clinical placements, or field research may require additional immunizations beyond those listed.

III. Procedure

Vaccinations may be subject to change based on fluctuation in disease outbreak, changes in State Law, and/or CDC recommendations. Please visit the UTMB Student Health website at this link for list of immunization requirements and possible exemptions.

Any student seeking an exemption from these requirements must contact the Student Health Office.
